B. Information

- Vanessa shared that the City of San Jose has a safe parking for RVs program modeled after the city of Mountain View's plans.
- There are over 9000 homeless in Santa Clara County
- City of San Jose homeless numbers for 2019: 6097 homeless individuals. 84% unsheltered and 17% reported living in their vehicle.

Vic Haddad (Treasurer) Michael Kirtland Brian Rice

- Stephanie shared that they are looking at the northern lot of the Santa Teresa VTA station for a safe parking lot for RVs.
- The city would put a wood fence around the area and would operate 24/7 with onsite staffing. Security would be onsite as well.
- There would be access to restrooms, hand washing stations, waste management and grey water disposal.
- There would be quiet hours and the site would be by referral only with no drive-up access.
- Next steps: 1) approval from VTA and city council, 2) community meetings and stakeholder outreach, 3) site preparations like fencing, and 4) contract with a site operator. There is not a specific start date yet.

o Sand Volleyball court refresh

1. Project will wait until later in the summer to begin.

o Consolidated liquid chlorine option

1. Still waiting to schedule an appointment with the vendor to come and look at the site. Not currently a priority.

o Solar Update

1. Waiting for the new contract from the solar company. Terrie will bring the contract back to the board for signatures. Solar install won't start until the fall.

o Facility priorities for opening

- 1. Many of the items on the list are complete, still working on the list.
- o Heat in back pool
 - 1. The heat in the back pool will be turned on April 1st.
- o Bathroom stall dividers
 - 1. There was a miscommunication about the new bathroom stalls they are metal and not plastic. Looking to see if it is possible to put something around the bottom to keep them from rusting.
- o Stucco Project Update
 - 1. Will start on March 2nd and it will take 3-4 weeks to complete. The plan is to be complete by opening weekend.
 - 2. Restrooms should be accessible during construction.
 - 3. Luke will complete the drywall after the stucco is done.

o Front parking lot

1. Luke fixed the holes in the front drive through parking lot.

B. Office Manager's update

- Due's summary & delinquent dues
 - o One property is \$1000 behind.
 - o Sent out 22 late notices for properties that owed \$200 or more, we are now down to 15.
- 2022 Associate membership status
